EXECUTIVE ANALYST REPORT

MATCH VERDICT

Ammerud BLNO won by 10 through the combined effect of 8.5 points of offensive-rating advantage, stronger shot conversion and the ability to protect more possessions.

- 1** SHOT VALUE: Bærum Basket 60.6% eFG% versus Ammerud BLNO 55.3%.
- 2** POSSESSION SECURITY: TOV% was 18.2% versus 15.6%.
- 3** OFFENSIVE REBOUNDING: OREB totals were 6 versus 13; extra chances must be connected to efficient scoring.
- 4** PACE: estimated possessions were 87.3 and 89.6, not simply the number of field-goal attempts.
- 5** GAME CONTROL: the scoring flow below identifies when the margin expanded or contracted.

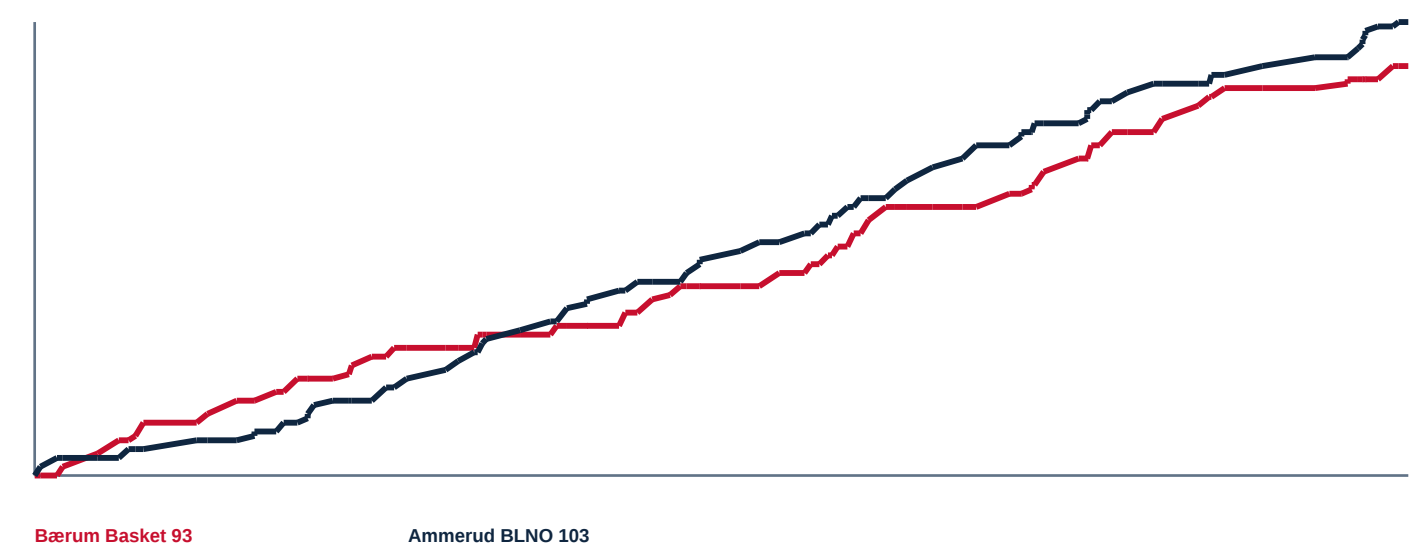

ANALYST NOTE

The pace profile is separated from the scoring profile: a team can play at similar volume but generate a very different number of points per possession. Ammerud BLNO scored 1.15 points per estimated possession.

WHAT THIS MEANS ON COURT

The comparison must distinguish makes, attempts and points. Identical three-point makes can coexist with very different efficiency if one team needs more attempts; the higher-leverage separator is usually the combination of two-point conversion, turnovers and free-throw pressure.

Classified attempts: 62/71 for Bærum Basket and 69/76 for Ammerud BLNO. No official shot-clock field exists in the source; windows are reconstructed from game-clock events, made baskets, rebounds, turnovers and qualifying resets.

Per 100 values are normalised to each team's estimated possessions. They are not season averages and should be interpreted alongside minutes and role.

PLAYER-LEVEL ANALYST READ

Ammerud BLNO: EFFICIENT CORE

Benjamin Dyve (8 pts, 100 TS%, 9.2 PTS/100), Oleksander Horiuk (28 pts, 77.8 TS%, 31.3 PTS/100), William Bryan Cranston-Lown (20 pts, 73.3 TS%, 22.3 PTS/100) led the most efficient scoring profiles among players with a meaningful attempt sample.

SCORING DISTRIBUTION

The leading scorers were Stian Mjøs (28), Oleksander Horiuk (28), Gabriel Max Hadley (25). The key question is whether the scoring came from sustainable shot quality, free throws or high-volume attempts.

CREATION AND SECURITY

Pau Tendero Salom supplied 10 assists. William Bryan Cranston-Lown recorded 7 turnovers, so creation quality must be evaluated together with possession cost.

DATA, METHODS AND CONFIDENCE

OFFICIAL BOX SCORE

Team and player totals come from the official match record.

POSSESSION FORMULA

Estimated possessions = FGA + 0.44 x FTA - OREB + TOV.

ADVANCED RATES

ORTG, DRTG, NET RTG, eFG%, TS%, TOV%, OREB%, FTr, AST/FGM% and 3PA rate are calculated from the box score.

PLAYER RATES

PTS/100, REB/100, AST/100, STL/100 and TO/100 use each team's estimated possessions. USG% is the player's estimated finishing share.

SHOT-TIME RECONSTRUCTION

The play-by-play has game-clock events but no official shot-clock field. Possession starts and resets are reconstructed from event order.

QUALITY CONTROL

874 play-by-play events were loaded; scoring is validated against the final score and malformed parent events are excluded from chronology calculations.

LIMITATION

This is a one-game descriptive analysis. It explains this match and does not establish a repeatable team identity without a larger sample.

FINAL COACHING CONCLUSIONS

FOR BÆRUM BASKET

Protect the most efficient shot areas, reduce possessions ending in live-ball turnovers and connect offensive rebounds to higher-value attempts. Compare the team's 2PT, 3PT and free-throw profile before making a shooting-only diagnosis.

FOR AMMERUD BLNO

Preserve the possession and shot-quality advantages that produced the result, but test whether the same profile survives against a different defensive scheme and a larger sample.

MATCH IN ONE SENTENCE

Ammerud BLNO combined the stronger points-per-possession profile with the better balance between shot value, possession security and scoring distribution.
